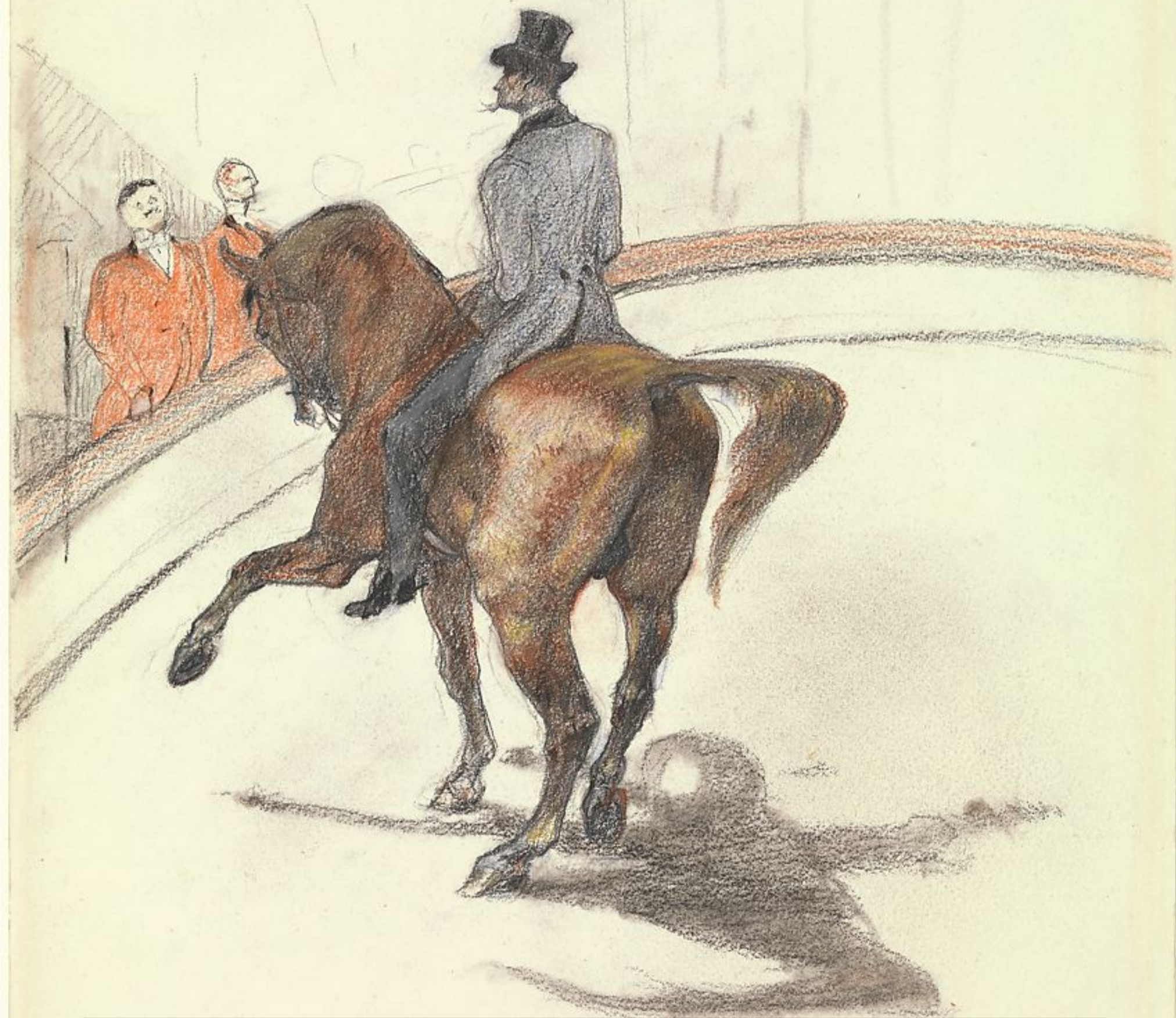

CHAMPAGNE RUN DRESSAGE SEASON

The Champagne Run dressage season will run from January 1st to November 30th 2020. Scores received during this period may be used to qualify for dressage awards. The season finals and award ceremony will be held the last weekend of January 2021.

2020 SHOW SCHEDULE

- January 26th - Dressage In The Afternoon
- March 8th - Dressage In The Afternoon
- March 22nd - Mini Trial, Combined Test, and Dressage Show
- June 14th - Mini Trial, Combined Test, and Dressage Show
- July - Freestyle Friday
- August 9th - Mini Trial, Combined Test, and Dressage Show
- September - Freestyle Friday
- October 24th - Octoberfest Horse Trials, Combined Test, and Dressage Show
- November - Dressage In The Afternoon

Schedule subject to change at the discretion of the organizer.



RIDER AWARDS

Champagne Run will recognize achievements in dressage through rider awards. Awards are performance rewarding to encourage riders to strive for consistent improvement in the discipline of dressage.

GENERAL RULES

Riders may earn Bronze, Silver, and Gold awards at the Introductory, Training, First, and Second Levels. All scores must be earned during the 2020 season to qualify for a medal. Scores will not be carried over into the next season. Riders may only receive one medal at each level during the 2020 season. Bronze, Silver, and Gold medals do not need to be earned sequentially. Medals may be earned on any horse.

TEST SUBMISSION

Riders are responsible for submitting qualifying scores to the Show Secretary within ten days of the ride. No more than two tests per show date may be used to qualify. Tests may be submitted via email to Nancy Clinkinbeard (nanclink56@gmail.com).

INTRODUCTORY LEVEL AWARDS

Qualifying scores must be from no less than two different tests listed below. Tests must be from at least three different show dates. Any combination of tests therein is permitted.

Permitted Tests:

- USDF Introductory Test A, B and C (Small Ring)
- USEA Beginner Novice Test A and B (Small Ring)

- WDAA Introductory Test 4 and Basic Test 1 (Small Ring)

Bronze Medal Requirements

Riders must provide six tests with a minimum score of 60%.

Silver Medal Requirements

Riders must provide five tests with a minimum score of 68%.

Gold Medal Requirements

Riders must provide four tests with a minimum score of 73%.

TRAINING LEVEL AWARDS

Permitted Tests:

- USDF Training Level Test 1, 2 and 3 (Small Ring)
- USEA Novice Test B will be accepted as equivalent to USDF Training Level Test 1

Bronze Medal Requirements

Riders must provide six tests with a minimum score of 60%

- Two at USDF Training Level Test 1 (may substitute USEA Novice Test B)
- Two at USDF Training Level Test 2
- Two at USDF Training Level Test 3

Silver Medal Requirements

Riders must provide five tests with a minimum score of 68%.

- Two at USDF Training Level Test 1 (may substitute USEA Novice Test B)
- Two at USDF Training Level Test 2
- Two at USDF Training Level Test 3

Gold Medal Requirements

Riders must provide four tests with a minimum score of 73%.

- Two at USDF Training Level Test 1 (may substitute USEA Novice Test B)
- Two at USDF Training Level Test 2
- Two at USDF Training Level Test 3

FIRST LEVEL AWARDS

Permitted Tests:

- USDF First Level Test 1, 2 and 3 (Small Ring)
- USEA Training Test B and Preliminary Test B will be accepted as equivalent to USDF First Level Test 1

Bronze Medal Requirements

Riders must provide six tests with a minimum score of 60%

- Two at USDF First Level Test 1 (may substitute USEA Training Test B and Preliminary Test B)
- Two at USDF First Level Test 2
- Two at USDF First Level Test 3

Silver Medal Requirements

Riders must provide five tests with a minimum score of 68%.

- Two at USDF First Level Test 1 (may substitute USEA Training Test B and Preliminary Test B)
- Two at USDF First Level Test 2
- Two at USDF First Level Test 3

Gold Medal Requirements

Riders must provide four tests with a minimum score of 73%.

- Two at USDF First Level Test 1 (may substitute USEA Training Test B and Preliminary Test B)
- Two at USDF First Level Test 2
- Two at USDF First Level Test 3

SECOND LEVEL AWARDS

Permitted Tests:

- USDF Second Level Test 1, 2 and 3 (Standard Ring)
- USEA Intermediate Test B will be accepted as equivalent to USDF Second Level Test 1

Bronze Medal Requirements

Riders must provide six tests with a minimum score of 60%

- Two at USDF Second Level Test 1 (may substitute USEA Intermediate Test B)
- Two at USDF Second Level Test 2
- Two at USDF Second Level Test 3

Silver Medal Requirements

Riders must provide five tests with a minimum score of 68%.

- Two at USDF Second Level Test 1 (may substitute USEA Intermediate Test B)
- Two at USDF Second Level Test 2
- Two at USDF Second Level Test 3

Gold Medal Requirements

Riders must provide four tests with a minimum score of 73%.

- Two at USDF Second Level Test 1 (may substitute USEA Intermediate Test B)
- Two at USDF Second Level Test 2
- Two at USDF Second Level Test 3



CHAMPAGNE RUN DRESSAGE FINALS

Champagne Run Dressage Finals and Award Ceremony will be held during the last weekend of January 2021. Medals earned during the 2020 season and Finals Awards will be presented to deserving riders.

DRESSAGE FINALS QUALIFICATIONS

Riders participating in the Dressage Finals must be eligible to receive a Dressage Medal from the 2020 season. Riders eligible for multiple medals must compete at the highest level at which they have achieved a medal. Scores received at Dressage Finals may be applied towards medals for the 2021 season.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

All tests will be standard arena USDF tests.

Medals will be awarded at the conclusion of Finals for each level.

Finals Awards will be given to the top ten competitors based solely on scores received at Dressage Finals.



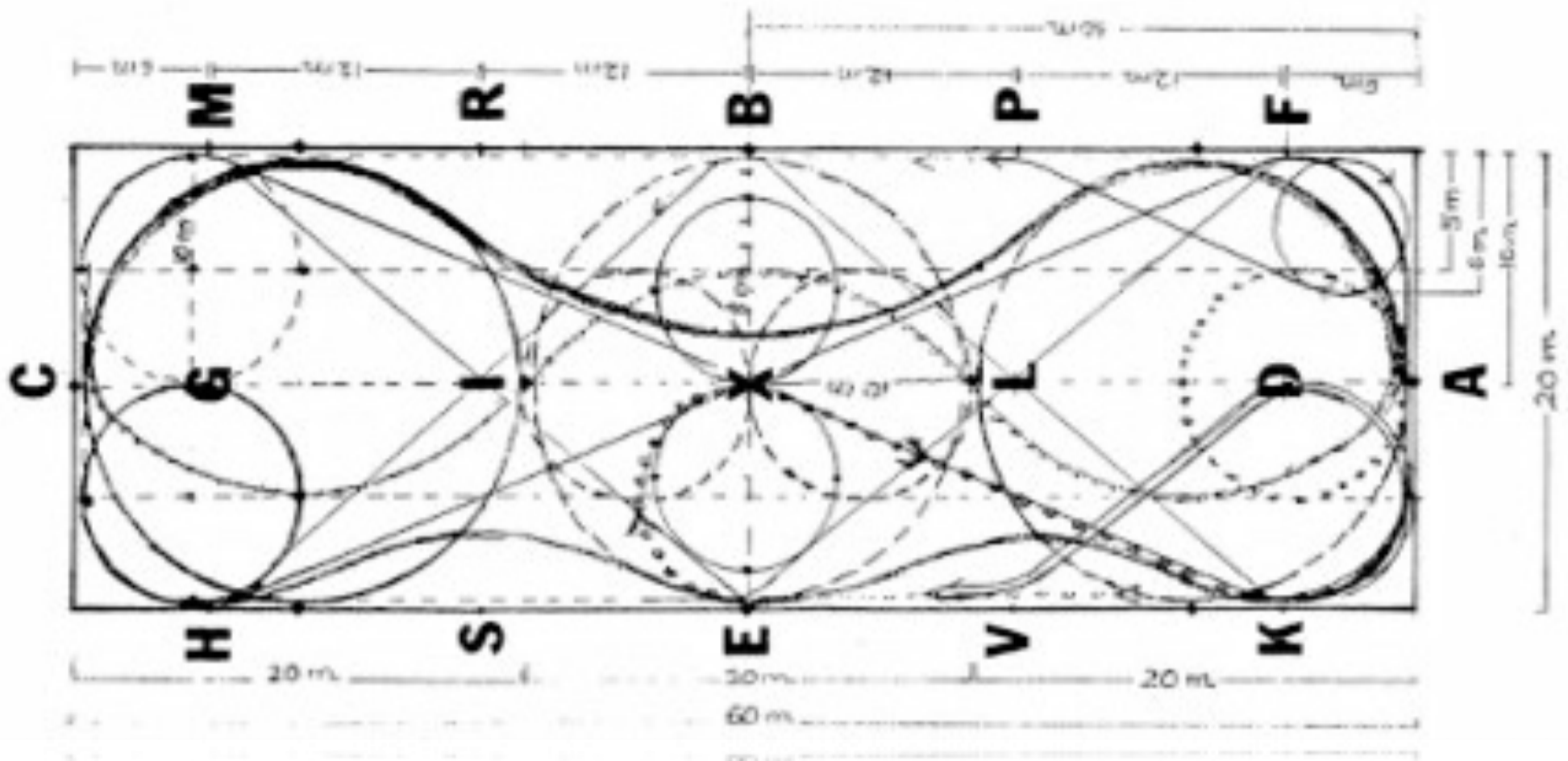

EXAMPLES

The following are examples of permissible test combinations at each award level:

INTRODUCTORY LEVEL

Rider A submitted:

- USDF Introductory Test A with a score of 63% on February 2nd
- WDAA Introductory Test 4 with a score of 66% on February 2nd
- USDF Introductory Test B with a score of 60% on June 3rd
- USDF Introductory Test A with a score of 72% on April 12th
- USDF Introductory Test C with a score of 69% on October 24th
- USEA Beginner Novice Test B with a score of 61% on November 2nd

Rider A has earned an Introductory Level Bronze Medal and has qualified for Introductory Level Dressage Finals

Rider B submitted:

- USDF Introductory Test A with a score of 69% on February 2nd
- USDF Introductory Test B with a score of 68% on February 2nd
- USDF Introductory Test B with a score of 76% on June 3rd
- USDF Introductory Test A with a score of 72% on April 12th
- USDF Introductory Test A with a score of 69% on October 24th
- USDF Introductory Test B with a score of 70% on November 2nd

Rider B has earned an Introductory Level Silver Medal and has qualified for Introductory Level Dressage Finals

TRAINING LEVEL

Rider A submitted:

- USDF Training Level Test 1 with a score of 63% on February 2nd
- USDF Training Level Test 2 with a score of 66% on February 2nd
- USDF Training Level Test 3 with a score of 60% on June 3rd
- USDF Training Level Test 3 with a score of 72% on April 12th
- USDF Training Level Test 2 with a score of 69% on October 24th
- USEA Novice Test B with a score of 61% on November 2nd

Rider A has earned a Training Level Bronze Medal and has qualified for Training Level Dressage Finals

Rider B submitted:

- USDF Training Level Test 1 with a score of 73% on February 2nd
- USDF Training Level Test 2 with a score of 76% on February 2nd
- USDF Training Level Test 1 with a score of 80% on June 3rd

- USDF Training Level Test 3 with a score of 73% on April 12th
- USDF Training Level Test 2 with a score of 79% on October 24th
- USDF Training Level Test 3 with a score of 78% on November 2nd

Rider B has earned a Training Level Gold Medal and has qualified for Training Level Dressage Finals

FIRST LEVEL

- USDF First Level Test 2 with a score of 63% on February 2nd
- USDF First Level Test 3 with a score of 66% on February 2nd
- USDF First Level Test 2 with a score of 60% on June 3rd
- USDF First Level Test 3 with a score of 72% on April 12th
- USEA Training Test B with a score of 69% on October 24th
- USEA Preliminary Test B with a score of 61% on November 2nd

Rider A has earned a First Level Bronze Medal and has qualified for First Level Dressage Finals

Rider B submitted:

- USDF First Level Test 1 with a score of 73% on February 2nd
- USDF First Level Test 3 with a score of 76% on February 2nd
- USDF First Level Test 1 with a score of 80% on June 3rd
- USDF First Level Test 2 with a score of 82% on April 12th
- USDF First Level Test 2 with a score of 79% on October 24th
- USEA First Level Test 3 with a score of 81% on November 2nd

- USEA Intermediate Test B with a score of 71% on November 2nd

Rider A has earned a Second Level Silver Medal and has qualified for Second Level Dressage Finals

- USDF Second Level Test 3 with a score of 76% on February 2nd
- USDF Second Level Test 1 with a score of 80% on June 3rd
- USDF Second Level Test 2 with a score of 82% on April 12th
- USDF Second Level Test 2 with a score of 79% on October 24th
- USEA Second Level Test 3 with a score of 81% on November 2nd
